King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang
Measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19

From current events that have spread the disease COVID-19, which now has infected a large number of people. There is an epidemic spreading rapidly and increasing in many countries. King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang is stepping up measures to prevent the spread of this disease. In order to maintain the health safety of personnel and students as well as the institution's operations, the following processes can be carried out as follows:

1. Persons traveling from countries at risk of becoming infected with COVID-19 shall proceed to receive an immediate physical examination at the KMITL Medical Centre for follow-up and further action.

2. Students and personnel who have a fever or have a risk of becoming infected with COVID-19 shall refrain from attending class or stop working to be treated until healed; in which case will not be considered as absent/leave from school or work, and will not be considered a lack of performance.

Students must get permission to be dismissed from attending at KMITL from their respective faculty departments/administrators. KMITL staff/personnel must get permission to be dismissed from the Office of Human Resource Management, Office of the President.

3. Cooperation of students and personnel to stop or postpone traveling to a country at risk of Infection with COVID-19.

4. Students and personnel with a history of returning from countries that are at risk of becoming infected with COVID-19 from 7 February 2020 to the date of publication are required to conduct a physical examination at the KMITL Medical Centre by February 24, 2020, for follow-up and further action.

5. Stop or postpone the invitation of people from countries with risk of COVID-19 infection to participate in activities, teaching, meetings, seminars, or proceeding in any other way.
