King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang
Measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19

As the World Health Organization (WHO) has issued the warning of the global spread of COVID-19, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang is stepping up the measures to prevent the spread of this disease. In order to maintain the health safety of students and staff members, the following measures shall be followed:

1. This announcement shall come into force from February 26, 2020 onwards.
2. All students or staff members having returned from any country are obligated to be placed under home quarantine for 14 days after arrival in Thailand. This self-quarantine shall not be considered as absence from class or work and not counted as leave days.

The said students or staff members shall notify the dean of their faculty. If the students are scheduled to sit the midterm exam during their 14-day quarantine, they shall inform the involved lecturers and request makeup exams later.

The said students and staff members are also obligated to notify the Institute of their arrivals via the E-office.

The Institute shall monitor the said students and staff members for 14 days starting from the date of their return to Thailand.

3. All students and staff members are asked for their cooperation to wear masks while on campus to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
