Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19: Issue 6

Due to the current incident of wider rapid severe outbreak of COVID-19 over and may cause problem against the actual instruction of the institute, KMITL deems it is appropriate to implement the issue 6 of the Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 to assure the efficiency of the instruction of the 2/2019 semester, the following processes shall be carried out as follows:

Item 1: For the instructional classes after the midterm of the 2/2019 semester, exceptional online classes with their actual contents may be considered by instructors to compensate or supplement the normal ones to let the students gain their knowledge as usual.

Item 2: All instructors requiring online classes shall follow the following requirements:

2.1 Official approval from the heads or representatives of academic Departments must be authorized.

2.2 Inform the students the necessity of the exceptional learning process in the condition of severe spread of COVID-19 and process the classes as cooperatively committed.

2.3 Before the online classes, the clear learning plan, assigned works, and evaluation form or test before the midterm must be informed to the students.

2.4 The proper channels to respond to related questions of the students must be clearly provided for each time of weeks.

2.5 The actual learning progress of the students must be inspected, monitored and evaluated continually.
