



## **Board of Directors' Statement on Student Support During the COVID-19 Pandemic King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang**

The COVID-19 pandemic has been affecting students directly and indirectly. Parents of some students are suffering from the economic fallout. King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang is committed to supporting students through the pandemic. Numerous student supports and assistance have been launched such as the tuition fee reduction, the dormitory room refund, the waiver of water supply, the off-campus rent mitigation negotiation, student financial aids, and free COVID-19 insurances for all students etc. However, the Institute realises that many more students are still experiencing financial challenges.

In this regard, the Institute's board of directors, which includes the President, Senior Executive Vice Presidents, Vice Presidents, Faculty Senate Chair, Faculty Senate Vice Chair, Deans, Vice Deans, Dean Assistants, Department Heads, Centre Heads, Office Directors, Vice Office Directors, Office Director Assistants, Academic Support Division Heads, and Office Heads, has agreed to donate part of their salaries to the KMITL Educational Fund for 6 months in an effort to help students strongly impacted by the pandemic. The donation of approximately 1,000,000 baht will be made to the fund each month, totaling approximately 6,000,000 baht in 6 months.
